SCHEME OF COMPUTER PROFICIENCY TEST FOR THE POST OF UPPER DIVISION CLERK (OBC) - 01 No.

The candidates shortlisted for the Computer Skill test will have to attend a Typing Test for 20 marks, in which typing speed and accuracy will be evaluated. The test is qualifying in nature. The minimum qualifying marks will be declared post examination.
